₹63 LAKH

Hit by losses incurred in engineering and project segment, Bajaj Electricals on Monday reported a sharp decline in net profit to ₹63 lakh for the January-March quarter, 2013, against ₹48.99 crore profit in the same

period last year. The company incurred a loss of ₹50.65 crore in the engineering and project segment in the period, the company said in a statement. Total income from operations of the company rose to ₹1,113.71 crore for the quarter

under review from ₹1,059.87 crore for the year ago period. In a filing to BSE, the company said its board has recommended a dividend of ₹2 per share on 9,97,55,331 equity shares of ₹2 each for 2012-13.
